POLICE REGULATIONS OF CROSSPARK AREA

SKICROSS AND SNOWBOARDCROSS

SPRING 2025

Article 1 – Scope of application

These rules of use define the access and usage conditions for the Puy Salié crosspark area.

These rules apply to all users of this zone throughout the 2 Alpes ski area.

All Crosspark area reservations imply acceptance of these rules.

Article 2 – Reservation conditions

Areas **reserved for national teams and regional committees.**

All other requests will be considered on a case-by-case basis depending on attendance (available for private teams with FIS or district athletes).

Reservations must be made on the website: <https://www.2alpestraining.com/>

Reservations will be approved after verification of the athletes' level. You will be informed, by email or telephone, of the validation of your Crosspark reservation

The group manager in charge of the reservation must fully pay for the use of the Crosspark in accordance with established rates (payment to be made at the “Point de vente Jandri” office).

Article 3 – Crosspark assignment and organisation

1. A daily schedule will be drawn up and displayed at the entrance of the JANDRI building, from **5:00 pm**. It will be available on the online platform <https://www.2alpestraining.com/>
2. The day before the reservation **by 3:30pm**, Teams must collect their armband(s) from the “Point de vente Jandri” office which will give access to the priority queue at the Jandri lift (6:30am) and the Puy Salié drag lift.
3. Every day, at the end of your course, you will be asked to return all armbands to the “Point de vente Jandri” office before **3:30pm**.
4. Bulky equipment such as bags and unused ski or snowboard equipment may be stored in a dedicated area on the right, at the top of the Jandri arrival. Please note that this is an outdoor and unsupervised area.
5. Since the return of equipment to the resort village cannot be guaranteed in the event of bad weather, coaches must keep abreast of weather conditions to ensure they are able to anticipate the return of their equipment (skis, poles, etc.) on the eve of their departure.

Article 4 – Crosspark area access and use

Users must:

- Use the course laid out by their coaches, who will have previously evaluated the risks of their inherent in the area (infrastructure, imminent dangers, etc.).
- Adapt their speed and behaviour to their personal abilities in order to ensure their own safety and that of other users.
- Strictly comply with markings, signs and information provided along the various slalom lanes.

Users are forbidden from:

- Using slalom lanes with closed access.
- Warming up at high speeds and ignoring the ten rules of skiing indicated on the slope map.
- Damaging the facilities in any manner whatsoever.
- Leaving rubbish on the glacier.

Article 5 – Setting up / clearing the layout and maintenance (start and course)

Coaches must wait at the top of the Crosspark area before tracing their course.

In order to preserve and guarantee the **quality of training** for all teams, the latter must ensure that the **start-line is kept in shape** before and after the training sessions. To this end, specific equipment for maintaining the start-line will be available to the teams in the dedicated Crosspark container.

Article 6 – Ski lift use conditions

Access is authorised in accordance with the facilities' regulations.

Any damage to the Jandri gondolas caused by disrespectful or inappropriate behaviour will be charged in full to the persons responsible. SATA 2 Alpes teams are entitled to establish the facts and to draw up a report accordingly.

Access times (ascent) as well as the priority queuing system and running orders, sent before your training sessions and displayed at the Jandri, must be respected.

Armbands allow reserved access to the following ski lifts:

- Jandri cable car (ascent and descent).
- Puy Salié 2 drag lift.
- Tk Dôme Sud drag lift
- Dome Nord drag lift (from 17th May to 6th July 2025)

Part of the Signal sector will be accessible as long as conditions permit.

Article 7 - Rates and conditions of sale

1. Crosspark area reservation

➤ Crosspark area

- **Small team (1-10 athletes):** € 150 per day and per team.
€ 800 per 6 days and per team.
- **Large team (> 10 athletes):** € 300 per day and per team.
€ 1 600 per 6 days and per team.

Maximum of 16 athletes allowed per team.

Maximum 50/60 athletes allowed on the course.

2. Refunds

In the event of cancellation/withdrawal:

- 16 days or more before the 1st day of the course: Full refund of the reservation cost.
- 15 to 8 days before the 1st day of the course: 50% refund of the reservation cost.
- From 7 days before the 1st day of the course: No refund. Total fees payment: 100%.

In the event of bad weather:

- "High altitude ski area" closed: Full refund of the reservation cost.
- "High altitude ski area" unusable: equipment out of order, storm: Full refund of the reservation cost.

Refunds and compensation are subject to the sole confirmation of training area managers after an evaluation of the glacier's skiability and weather conditions.

3. Equipment loss

Any lost or unreturned armband will be charged at €30 per armband.

Article 8 - Violations of the rules

Slalom area and glacier sector managers are authorized to register violations of these rules and to decide the exclusion of a participant or of their group, with immediate effect.
