

POLICE REGULATIONS OF PRIVATE SPACES SPRING 2025

Article 1 – Scope of application

These rules of use define the access and usage conditions for the Puy Salié private slalom spaces.

These rules apply to all users of this zone throughout the 2 Alpes ski area.

All corridor reservations imply acceptance of these rules.

Article 2 - Reservation conditions

Areas reserved for national teams and regional committees.

All other requests will be considered on a case-by-case basis depending on attendance (available for private teams with FIS or district athletes).

To make a reservation request for a Premium corridor:

- Reserve a Standard Corridor on the website: https://www.2alpestraining.com/
- Reserve a Premium Space on the website https://www.2alpestraining.com/ or directly at the "Espaces Slalom" office at 3200m.

Reservation requests for private corridors will be approved after verification of the athlete's level, and validated the day before for the next day, at the "Espaces Slalom" office at 3200, during the daily meeting at 10:30 am

You will be informed of the confirmation of the reservation of your Private corridor by e-mail or telephone. Payment must be made no later than 3:30pm, the day before the reservation at the "Point de vente Jandri" office.

Article 3 – Premium corridors assignment and organisation

- 1. A daily schedule will be drawn up and displayed at the entrance of the JANDRI building, from **5:00 pm**. It will be available on the online platform https://www.2alpestraining.com/
- 2. The day before the reservation by 3:30pm, teams must come to the "Point de vente Jandri" office and collect their armband(s) which will give access to the priority queue at the Jandri (at 6:30am) and the Puy Salié drag lift.
- 3. Every day, at the end of your course, you will be asked to return all armbands to the "Point de vente Jandri" office before **3:30 pm.**
- 4. Bulky equipment such as bags and unused ski or snowboard equipment may be stored in a dedicated area on the right, at the top of the Jandri arrival. Please note that this is an outdoor and unsupervised area.
- Coaches are required to inform themselves of weather forecasts and conditions so as to anticipate the
 descent of their equipment in the event of bad weather the day before their departure. The SATA teams
 accept no responsibility for returning any equipment to the resort in the event of bad weather or closure of
 the Glacier.

Article 4 - Slalom area access and use

Users must:

- Use the course laid out by their coaches, who will have previously evaluated the risks inherent in the area (infrastructure, imminent dangers, etc.).
- Adapt their speed and behaviour to their personal abilities in order to ensure their own safety and that of other users.
- Strictly comply with slope markings, signs and information provided along the various slalom corridors.

Users are forbidden from:

- Using slalom corridors when access is closed.
- Warming up at high speeds and ignoring the ten rules of safe skiing indicated on the ski map.
- Damaging the facilities in any manner whatsoever.

Leaving rubbish on the glacier.

Article 5 - Slope tracing

Coaches must wait at the top of the slalom area before tracing the assigned corridor. Tracing begins at corridor number one and continues in numerical order.

Premium Giant & Slalom corridor:

Only one slope tracing per corridor for the giant and slalom (max distance between gates of 28 m).

Premium Speed corridor:

Use of the speed training space is subject to specific conditions: two mandatory lines for a speed layout (distance between gates of 30 m to 50 m).

To preserve their quality, corridors must be smoothed over at the end of each course.

Article 6 - Ski lift use conditions

Access is authorised in accordance with the facilities' regulations.

Any damage to the Jandri gondolas caused by disrespectful or inappropriate behaviour will be charged in full to the persons responsible. SATA 2 Alpes teams are entitled to establish the facts and to draw up a report accordingly.

Armbands allow reserved access to the following ski lifts:

- Jandri (ascent and descent).
- Puy Salié 2 drag lift.
- Dôme Nord drag lift.

Part of the Signal sector and 2600m will be accessible as long as conditions permit.

Article 7 - Rates and conditions of sale

1. Private corridor reservation

- Premium Giant Corridor in Puy Salié from 5 May to 28 May 2025 inclusive: 210 euros per day and per corridor.
- Premium Giant Corridor in Puy Salié from 29 May to 6 july 2025 inclusive: 420 euros per day and per corridor.

Maximum of 16 racers allowed per corridor. A maximum of two additional athletes can be added for 40€/day/athlete.

- Premium Speed Corridor from 5 May to 28 May 2025 included : €420 per day and per course (Piste Ecrin or Signal, depending on snow conditions).
- Premium Speed Corridor from 29 May to 6 july 2025 included : €840 per day and per course (in the premium space, depending on snow conditions).

Maximum of 36 racers allowed per corridor.

2. Refunds

In the event of cancellation/withdrawal:

- 16 days or more before the 1st day of the course: Full refund of the reservation cost.
- 15 to 8 days before the 1st day of the course: 50% refund of the reservation cost.
- From 7 days before the 1st day of the course: No refund. Total fees payment: 100%.

In the event of bad weather:

- "High altitude ski area" closed: Full refund of the reservation cost.
- "High altitude ski area" unusable: equipment out of order, storm: Full refund of the reservation cost.

Refunds and compensation are subject to the sole confirmation of training area managers after an evaluation of the glacier's skiability and weather conditions.

3. Equipment loss

Any lost or unreturned armband will be charged at €30 per armband.

Article 8 - Violations of the present rules

Slalom area and glacier sector managers are authorized to register violations of these rules and can decide to exclude the participant or of the group, which can take effect immediately.
